

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Trinidad, Bohol

as of 30 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 May 2023 at around 7:12 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Trinidad, Bohol causing damages to several houses, two (2) commercial buildings and a boarding house. The fire was declared out at around 8:00 AM.

A total of **41 families** or **58 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Trinidad, Bohol** (see Table 1).
