### I. Situation Overview

On 01 May 2023 at around 3:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion del Sur, Villaba, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 8AM.

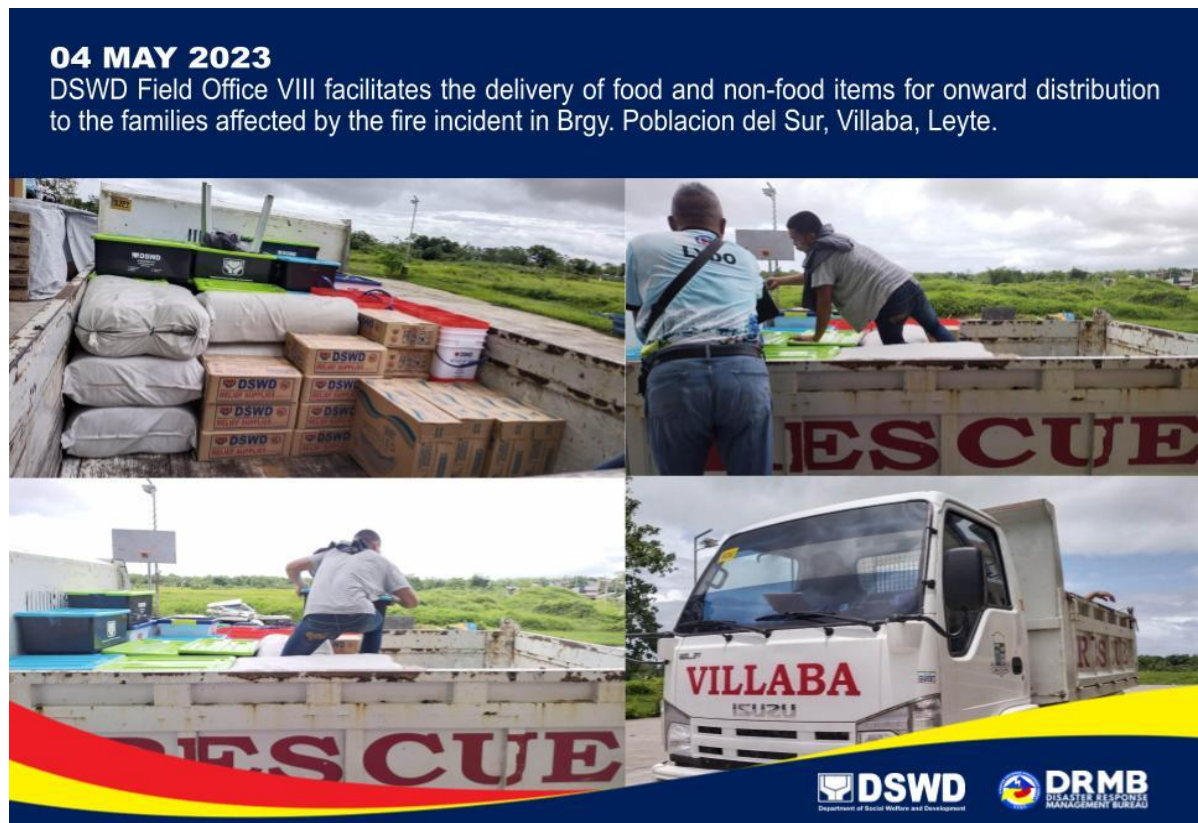
