

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Antonio, Parañaque City

as of 22 May 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 18 May 2023 at around 12:06 PM, a fire incident occurred at Hontiveros Compound, 4<sup>th</sup> Estate, Brgy. San Antonio, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 7PM.
