I. Situation Overview

On 18 May 2023 at around 12:06 PM, a fire incident occurred at Hontiveros Compound, 4th Estate, Brgy. San Antonio, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 7PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱538.96 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.90 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 110,525 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 101,525 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 9,142 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 2,000 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱243.61 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

b. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

18 May 2023	 The LGU of Parañaque City through its City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) conducted master listing, assessment, and validation of the affected families. The DSWD FO NCR through Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) facilitated the hauling of the requested food and non-food items (FNIs) of the CSWDO of the LGU of Parañaque City for distribution to the affected families.

c. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
18 May 2023	 DSWD FO NCR continuously coordinates with the CSWDO of the LGU of Parañaque City for significant disaster response update and any request of relief augmentation. DSWD FO NCR deployed its Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) Team to conduct assessment and monitoring in the affected area.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO NCR for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
