



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. Malinawon, Mawab, Davao de Oro

as of 08 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 May 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms due to Easterlies / Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms over Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day, flooding was experienced in several areas in Brgy. Malinawon, Mawab, Davao de Oro.

- 40,217 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 18,589 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 21,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

- ₱224.95 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.
