



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Maasin, Iloilo

as of 18 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 May 2023 partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by ITCZ / Localized Thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 3:00PM, several barangays in the municipality of Maasin, loilo experienced flooding due to heavy rains.

• ₱878.99 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 76,329 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 67,187 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 9,142 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 71,982 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱233.08 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
