

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Sto. Tomas, Davao del Norte

as of 17 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 May 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by the ITCZ / Localized Thunderstorms may have caused possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On 14-15 May 2023, flooding was experienced in several barangays in the municipality of Sto. Tomas, Davao del Norte.
