

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Social Disorganization in Maitum, Sarangani

as of 03 May 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 22 April 2023 at around 6:45 PM, a social disorganization incident transpired at Sitio Bantog, Brgy. Mindupok, Maitum, Sarangani which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.
