I. Situation Overview

On 22 April 2023 at around 6:45 PM, a social disorganization incident transpired at Sitio Bantog, Brgy. Mindupok, Maitum, Sarangani which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱24.48 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items
