



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Tawas, Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro

as of 15 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 May 2023 at around 10 PM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Pastuhan, Brgy. Tawas, Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro between the troops of the 203rd Infantry Brigade, 2nd Infantry Division of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (CPP-NPA) that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **67 families** or **276 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro** (see Table 2).
