I. Situation Overview

On 18 April 2023 at around 10:50 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 5, Brgy. San Vicente, Kapatagan, Lanao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 11:20 AM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) X

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **15 families** or **53 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Vicente, Kapatagan, Lanao del Norte** (see Table 1).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 46,015 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 16,887 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 29,128 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 42,156 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.
- ₱269.42 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO X warehouses.

b. Other Activities

02 May 2023	 DSWD FO X coordinated with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) and Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) of the LGU of Kapatagan, Lanao del Norte for significant disaster response update and any request of relief augmentation.
