



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flashflood Incidents in Region XII

as of 17 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 May 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by the Southwesterly Surface Windflow / Localized may have brought possible flashfloods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day, several municipalities in the provinces of Sultan Kudarat, South Cotabato, and Cotabato Province experienced flashfloods.

A total of 1,643 families or 5,739 persons are affected in 11 barangays in Region XII (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱878.99 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 60,729 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 51,587 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 9,142 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 22,981 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱270.96 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
