



# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Hilamonan, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental

as of 15 May 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 11 May 2023 at around 4:30 PM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the Philippine Army and members of the New People's Army (NPA) in Brgy. Hilamnonan, Kabankalan City that also affected the nearby Brgy. Buenavista of Himamaylan City in Negros Occidental.
