



# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Tawas, Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro

as of 24 May 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 May 2023 at around 10 PM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Pastuhan, Brgy. Tawas, Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro between the troops of the 203<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Brigade, 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (CPP-NPA) that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.
