I. Situation Overview

On 26 April 2023 at around 1:32 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 22, Cavite City. The fire was declared out at 10:37 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱878.99 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5.49 million available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 60,729 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 51,587 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 9,142 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 37,953 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱245.55 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

DATE	ACTIVITIES
08 May 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON conducted distribution of FFPs to the affected families. The City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Cavite City would distribute the FFPs to those who have not received yet.
27 April 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON, in coordination with the City/Municipal Action Teams (C/MATs), facilitated the delivery of additional FNIs from the National Resource and Logistics Management Bureau (NRLMB) and the distribution of the said FNIs to the families displaced by the fire incident.
26 April 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON facilitated the immediate provision of relief assistance to the families affected by the fire incident.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

DATE	ACTIVITIES
11 May 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON provided technical assistance to the CCCM focal person of the LGU of Cavite City on the administration of the Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC) to track the movement of the internally displaced persons (IDPs) and the assistance provided to them.





DATE	ACTIVITIES
27 April 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON provided technical assistance to the CSWDO of the LGU of Cavite City relative to the management of the evacuation centers and information management since there are fire incidents in their locality that are being managed. DSWD FO CALABARZON activated the C/MATs to assist the LGU of Cavite City in the conduct of validation of IDPs in evacuation centers and assess their current situation.

d. Other Activities

11 May 2023	DSWD FO CALABARZON Regional Director Barry R. Chua led the distribution of Emergency Cash Transfer (ECT) to the target beneficiaries. Sen. Bong Revilla, Cong. Jolo Revilla, and Cong. Bryan Revilla also graced the activity.
01 May 2023	• Members of the Regional Quick Response Team (QRT) were deployed to conduct damage assessment and needs analysis (DANA) in the evacuation centers. They have also provided technical assistance on internally displaced person (IDP) tracking and reporting of assistance provided to the affected families.
28 April 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON Assistant Regional Director for Operations (ARDO) and Assistant Regional Director for Administration (ARDA) joined DSWD Secretary Rex Gatchalian during the dialogue meeting with Cavite City Mayor Denver Christopher Chua, Cavite 1st District Rep. Ramon Jolo Revilla III, nad AGIMAT Party-List Rep. Bryan Revilla to discuss the plans for the provision of early recovery interventions to the affected families.
27 April 2023	 The DSWD spearheaded by Assistant Secretary for Disaster Response Management Group (DRMG) Diana Rose S. Cajipe, Special Assistant to the Secretary (SAS) Marlon A. Alagao, and DSWD FO CALABARZON ARDO Mylah S. Gatchalian together with Cavite 1st District Rep. Ramon Jolo Revilla III and Cavite City Mayor Denver Christopher Chua, monitored the situation of the families affected by the fire incident. DSWD FO CALABARZON through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) and Crisis Intervention Section (CIS) closely coordinated with the CSWDO of the LGU of Cavite City in assessing the incident for further provision of necessary assistance to the families affected by the fire incident. DSWD FO CALABARZON closely coordinated with other concerned offices for significant updates and any request of relief augmentation.
26 April 2023	DSWD FO CALABARZON closely coordinated with the Logistics Cluster of Cavite City and Cavite Province for the transportation of FNIs to the affected area.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO CALABARZON for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
