

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 310, Sta. Cruz, Manila City as of 17 May 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 May 2023 at around 2:49 AM, a fire incident occurred at Oroquieta St., Brgy. 310, Sta. Cruz, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1PM.
