1. Standby Funds

- ₱902.36 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.9 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 46,015 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 16,887 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 29,128 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 1,200 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

05 May 2023	 DSWD FO NCR through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) distributed family kits, kitchen kits, and sleeping kits to the families affected or persons by the fire incident.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

04 May 2023	 The LGU of Parañaque City through its City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) conducted assessment, validation, and master listing of the affected families.

d. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
04 May 2023	 DSWD FO NCR coordinated with the CSWDO of the LGU of Parañaque City for significant disaster response update and any request of relief augmentation. DSWD FO NCR deployed its Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) Team to immediately assess the status of the affected families. DSWD FO NCR ensured availability of FNIs for possible relief augmentation to the LGU of Parañaque City.
