I. Situation Overview

On 26 April 2023 at around 10:35 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Kilowang, Brgy. Luz Banzon, Jasaan, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at 11:45 AM.

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}160,835.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}85,835.00\$ from DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}15,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) and \$\mathbb{P}60,000.00\$ from other Partners (see Table 6).

1. Standby Funds
