I. Situation Overview

On 15 May 2023 at around 3:12 PM, a fire incident occurred in barangays Talon Uno and Talon Singko, Las Piñas City. The fire was declared out at around 9:30 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) NCR

A total of **420 families** or **1,650 persons** are affected in **Las Piñas City** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱878.99 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.9 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 89,229 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 80,087 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 9,142 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 2,000 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱228.72 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
