

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Talon Uno and Talon Singko, Las Piñas City as of 19 May 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 15 May 2023 at around 3:12 PM, a fire incident occurred in barangays Talon Uno and Talon Singko, Las Piñas City. The fire was declared out at around 9:30 PM.
