

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Esperanza, Carmen, Surigao del Sur

22 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 April 2023 at around 10:10 PM, an armed conflict between the troops of 36th Infantry Battalion and the alleged members of the New People's Army (NPA) transpired at Sua, Brgy. Esperanza, Carmen, Surigao del Sur. This has caused fear among the residents in the neighboring areas which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals from Brgy. San Roque, Madrid, Surigao del Sur.

A total of **29 families** or **117 persons** sought temporary shelter at **San Roque Elementary School** in **Brgy. San Roque, Madrid, Surigao del Sur** (see Table 2).
