

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flooding Incident in Magdiwang, Romblon

I. Situation Overview

On 13 December 2022, the Municipality of Magdiwang, Romblon experienced flooding due to the overflowing of rivers and related tributaries caused by continuous heavy rains. The flooding economically affected the livelihood of the fisherfolks and farmers in Magdiwang, Romblon.

A total of **1,000 families** or **2,459 persons** were affected in **nine (9) barangays** in **Magdiwang, Romblon** (see Table 1).
