

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental

06 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2022, residents of Sitio Manaol, Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental reported ground fissures and landslides in their area. On 15 August 2022, the LGU of Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental through its Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) confirmed soil liquefaction in the said area and prompted the pre-emptive evacuation of the affected residents and advised them to remain in the evacuation center. Few more families and individuals were evacuated from 17 to 19 August 2022.

On 11 October 2022, the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) in Region VI released the results of its survey of the ground cracks and reported that they were part of a landslide which occurred in 2009. Further, MGB reported that the landslide, which is estimated to have a length of 2.34 kilometers and an area of 0.97 square kilometers, is called an "active creeping landslide."

On 20 October 2022, the MDRRMO issued safety clearance for the residents to return to their residences.
