

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Series of Shooting Incidents in Pikit, North Cotabato

13 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

From January to March 2023, a series of shooting incidents transpired in several barangays in Pikit, North Cotabato. The first incident occurred on 24 January 2023 and was reported to continue with several more encounters on 14 and 16 February 2023, and 20 March 2023.

The shooting incidents economically affected the lives of the families and persons residing in the affected barangays.

A total of **1,154 families** or **5,770 persons** were affected in **20 barangays** in **Pikit, North Cotabato** (see Table 1).
