



## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Poswoy, Balbalan, Kalinga

09 July 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 03 May 2023 at around 3:50 PM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Angod, Brgy. Poswoy, Balbalan, Kalinga between the forces of 50<sup>th</sup> IB under the 503<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Brigade of the Philippine Army and members of the New People's Army (NPA). The Balbalan Municipal Police Station (MPS) immediately conducted checkpoints in strategic locations for possible apprehension of the NPA.

Farmers are restricted from visiting their farms and the residents of Sitio Angod from travelling outside the barangay while the clearing operation in the area is ongoing. This made it difficult for them to secure food for their families and their daily activities are disrupted due to fear and anxiety from the incident.
