

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of LPA

18 December 2023, 6PM

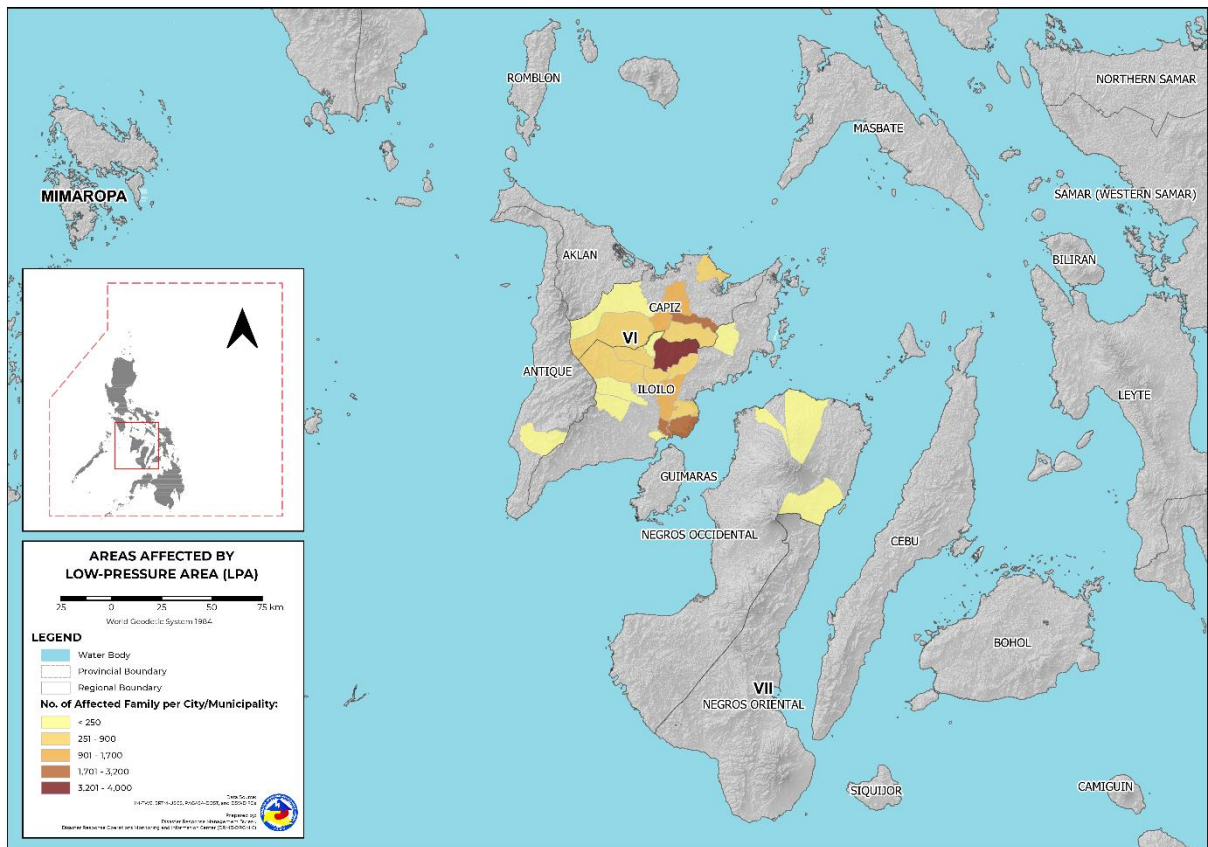
## I. Situation Overview

On 07 May 2023 at 4PM, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 410 km North Northeast of Pagasa Island, Palawan (14.5°N, 115.6°E).

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **23,144 families** or **92,022 persons** are affected in **280 barangays** in **Region VI** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **4,470 families** or **18,848 persons** sought temporary shelter in **138 evacuation centers** in **Region VI** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **4,419 families** or **17,030 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **8,889 families** or **35,878 persons** were displaced in **Region VI** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **178 houses** were damaged; of which, **51** are **totally damaged** and **127** are **partially damaged** in **Region VI** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱17,882,059.98** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱15,091,649.88** from **DSWD** and **₱2,790,410.10** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
