





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 22, Cavite City

30 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 April 2023 at around 1:32 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 22, Cavite City that also affected nearby barangays and resulted in the displacement of families and persons. The fire was declared out at 10:37 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **731 families** or **2,946 persons** were affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Cavite City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **703 families** or **2,826 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Cavite City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **28 families** or **120 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **731 families** or **2,946 persons** were displaced (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **700 houses** were **totally damaged** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱23,288,790.94 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱4,827,125.94 was from DSWD, ₱18,435,665.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) and ₱26,000.00 from Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) (see Annex F).

VI. Other Activities
