

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cabinet Hill-Teachers Camp, Baguio City

12 September 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 May 2023 at around 11:57 PM, a fire incident occurred at Leonard Wood Rd., Brgy. Cabinet Hill-Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 1:19 AM.
