

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Old Capitol Site, Quezon City

24 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

A fire incident took place on May 21, 2023, at the intersection of Dahlia and Camia Streets in Barangay Old Capital Site, Diliman, Quezon City. The fire commenced at 3:46 in the afternoon and was officially declared extinguished by 5:00 pm.

As per the report provided by the City Social Services Development Department, a total of 174 families, comprising 582 individuals, were affected by the said incident. Likewise, the Department of Social Welfare and Development through its Field Office-National Capital Region (NCR) and the Quezon City Local Government Unit promptly initiated the provision of assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.
