

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Maasin, Iloilo

16 November 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 13 May 2023 partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by ITCZ / Localized Thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 3:00 PM, several barangays in the municipality of Maasin, Iloilo experienced flooding due to heavy rains.

A total of **54 families** or **260 persons** were affected in **Maasin, Iloilo** (see Table 1).
