





## DSWD DROMC Terminal Report on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Bayawa, President Quirino, Sultan Kudarat

19 February 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 13 June 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by the Southwest Monsoon/Localized Thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 5PM, a flash flood incident occurred in Brgy. Bayawa, President Quirino, Sultan Kudarat.
