

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Mindupok, Maitum, Sarangani

as of 15 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 June 2023 at around 12:30 PM, an armed conflict between two (2) MILF groups transpired at Sitio Badol, Brgy. Mindupok, Maitum, Sarangani which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

A total of **359 families** or **1,184 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mindupok, Maitum, Sarangani** (see Table 1).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **359 families** or **1,184 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **five (5) evacuation centers** in **Maitum, Sarangani** (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 187,960 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 100,918 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 87,042 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 41,146 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱295.6 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
