



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Mindupok, Maitum, Sarangani

as of 15 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 June 2023 at around 12:30 PM, an armed conflict between two (2) MILF groups transpired at Sitio Badol, Brgy. Mindupok, Maitum, Sarangani which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **359 families** or **1,184 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mindupok**, **Maitum**, **Sarangani** (see Table 1).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **359 families** or **1,184 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **five (5) evacuation centers** in **Maitum**, **Sarangani** (see Table 2).
