

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental

as of 15 June 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 13 June 2023, an armed conflict between the Philippine Army and the New People's Army (NPA) transpired in the neighboring barangays of Agogolo and Macagahay Proper in Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

A total of **56 families** or **280 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Negros Occidental** (see Table 1).

- 187,960 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 100,918 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 87,042 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 64,121 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱280.1 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
