I. Situation Overview

On 29 May 2023 at around 1:15 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 42, Tacloban City, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 4PM.

There are 16 families or 61 persons currently taking temporary shelter in four (4) evacuation centers in Tacloban City, Leyte (see Table 2).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 122,517 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 43,975 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 78,542 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 58,193 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱231.78 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.


b. Other Activities

DSWD FO VIII through the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) with the CSWDO of the LGU of Tacloban City conducted ocular visit in the affected area to monitor the situation of the affected families.
