

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Alang-alang, Mandaue City, Cebu

### I. Situation Overview

On 28 June 2023 at around 5:02 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Abra, Brgy. Alang-alang, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 6:08 AM.
