1. Standby Funds

- ₱130.78 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO II.

- 185,055 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 98,013 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 87,042 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 79,956 FFPs available at DSWD FO II.
- ₱280.45 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO II warehouses.
