1. Standby Funds

- ₱130.78 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO II.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 185,055 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 98,013 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 87,042 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 79,956 FFPs available at DSWD FO II.
- ₱280.45 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO II warehouses.

c. Other Activities

14 June 2023	 DSWD FO II through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) provided financial assistance worth ₱10,000.00 to each affected family. DSWD FO II coordinated with the LGU of Quezon, Isabela for significant disaster response updates and any request of relief augmentation.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO II for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.

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
