

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Canmogsay, Tolosa, Leyte

as of 18 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 June 2023 at around 3:19 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Canmogsay, Tolosa, Leyte. The fire was declared out on the same day with the immediate response of the firefighters of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) Leyte.
