



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Inayawan, Cebu City and Brgy. San Roque, Talisay City, Cebu

as of 13 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 June 2023 at around 1:24PM, a fire incident affected the neighboring barangays of Brgy. Inayawan in Cebu City and Brgy. San Roque in Talisay City. The fire was declared out at around 1:50PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱147.68 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 170,057 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 95,515 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 73,542 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 49,723 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱287.48 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
