I. Situation Overview

On 31 May 2023 at around 8PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lantad, Silay City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 8:53 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱130.78 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 189,455 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 102,413 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 87,042 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 66,333 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱205.99 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
