



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in the Passenger Vessel MV Esperanza Star

as of 19 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 June 2023 at around 4AM, the passenger vessel MV Esperanza Star of KHO Shipping Lines caught fire within the seawater vicinity of Brgy. Doljo, Panglao, Bohol.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱906.64 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 224,350 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 121,408 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 102,942 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 49,673 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱261.51 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

18 June 2023	 KHO Shipping Lines provided FNIs such as ready-to-eat meals, water, and clothes, and ₱5,000.00 financial assistance to each of the affected passengers. They have also arranged transit of these passengers to Cebu. The LGU of Tagbilaran provided pre-loved clothes to affected passengers.

c. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
18 June 2023	 DSWD FO VII coordinated with concerned offices for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation. DSWD FO VII provided financial assistance to the affected passengers through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) amounting to a total of ₱68,000.00.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO VII for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
