2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 179,160 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 105,618 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 73,542 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 46,899 FFPs available at DSWD FO III.
- ₱313.41 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO III warehouses.
