

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Heavy Rainfall and Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Mangelen, President Quirino, Sultan Kudarat as of 20 June 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 11 June 2023 at 5AM, heavy rains with strong wind were experienced in Brgy. Mangelen, President Quirino, Sultan Kudarat due to localized thunderstorms causing damages to houses.
