



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Heavy Rainfall and Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Mangelen, President Quirino, Sultan Kudarat

I. Situation Overview

On 11 June 2023 at 5AM, heavy rains with strong wind were experienced in Brgy. Mangelen, President Quirino, Sultan Kudarat due to localized thunderstorms causing damages to houses.

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 232,646 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 132,804 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 99,842 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 40,146 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
