

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Landslide Incident in Manay, Davao Oriental

as of 13 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 May 2023, a rain-induced landslide and mudslide occurred in Manay, Davao Oriental which blocked the roads leading to several areas in the municipality.

Reports indicate that these types of road block severely affected the economic and livelihood activities of the residents in Brgy. Taocanga who are mostly farmers.

A total of **600 families** or **1,920 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Taocanga** in **Manay, Davao Oriental** (see Table 1).
