



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Bualo Lipid, Maimbung, Sulu

as of 28 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 June 2023, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Bualo Lipid, Maimbung, Sulu between government troops and members of an alleged private armed group maintained by a former vice mayor in Maimbung, Sulu who is also a Moro National Liberation Front (MNLF) leader.

Reports indicated that the troops were about to serve search and arrest warrants against former Maimbung Vice Mayor Pando Mudjasan when the firefight began. According to the Philippine National Police (PNP), the Mudjasan group opened fire at the approaching authorities, prompting the latter to return fire.

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,163 families or 5,815 persons currently taking temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Maimbung, Sulu (see Table 2).

- ₱294.41 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO IX warehouses.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO IX for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
