



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Macagahay, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental

as of 16 June 2023, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 13 June 2023, an armed conflict between the Philippine Army and the New People's Army (NPA) transpired in Brgy. Macagahay, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **119 families** or **334 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Macagahay, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental** (see Table 1).

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **119 families** or **334 persons** who sought temporary shelter in **two (2)** evacuation centers in Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental (see Table 2).
