



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of African Swine Fever in Hamtic, Antique

as of 29 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 June 2023, the Municipality of Hamtic, Antique was placed under State of Calamity (SoC) due to the spread of the African Swine Fever (ASF) as several cases were confirmed by the Department of Agriculture – Regional Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory (DA-RADDL).

ASF is a highly contagious viral disease of domestic and wild pigs, where mortality rate can reach 100%. It is not a danger to human health, but it has devastating effects on pig populations and the farming economy. There is currently no effective vaccine against ASF. The virus is highly resistant in the environment, meaning that it can survive on clothes, boots, wheels, and other materials. It can also survive in various pork products, such as ham, sausages or bacon.

A total of **525 families** or **2,585 persons** are affected in **28 barangays** in **Hamtic**, **Antique** (see Table 1).
