I. Situation Overview

On 29 May 2023 at around 1:15 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 42, Tacloban City, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 4PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱146.78 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 169,963 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 80,921 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 89,042 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 58,193 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱258.62 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.
